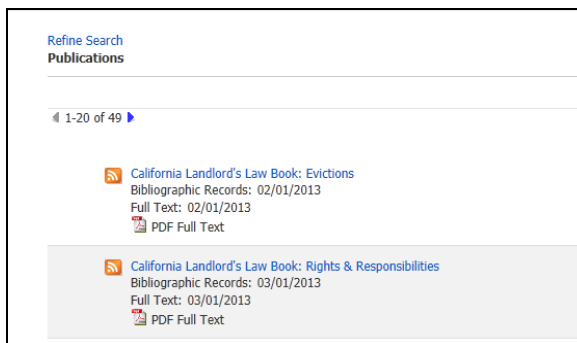

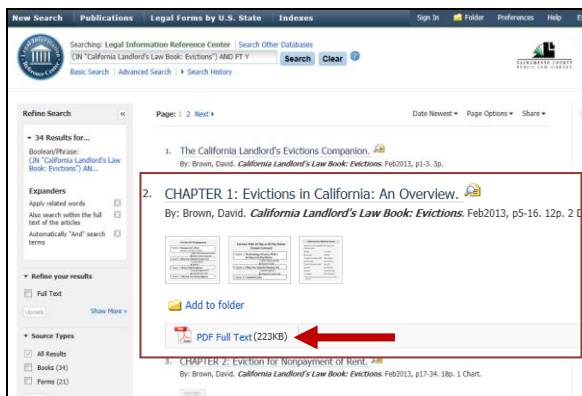
The result will be a list of titles.
