
Privacy Policy

This privacy policy describes how the Sacramento County Public Law Library uses personal information collected at this site. Please read this policy carefully before using the site or submitting any personal information. By using this site, you are accepting the practices described in this privacy policy. Websites you link to from saclaw.org (<https://saclaw.org>) may have privacy provisions that differ from those of the library's website.

SCPLL collects non-identifying information to improve the functionality, content, and performance of the library's website. When you visit saclaw.org, we collect information regarding:

- Your Internet location (IP address)
- The pages you visit on our website
- The web page from which you came to our site
- The software you use to visit our site

The library does not:

- Collect personally identifiable information unless you voluntarily provide it to us
- Provide or sell any information to outside agencies

We use email addresses to answer email we receive. These addresses are not used for any other purpose, and are not shared with outside parties. If you wish to receive email notices about library news and upcoming events, you may register for our email listserv. Email addresses provided for this purpose are not used in other ways, nor are they shared with third parties.

When requesting free MCLE Self-study videos on our online catalog, you will be required to provide personally identifying information, including your name and address to create an account on our website (saclaw.org). We do not share this information with outside parties.

The library collaborates with other Law Libraries for free live MCLE webinar events. For these events, you will be redirected to a third-party event booking service (e.g., Eventbrite, Zoom, Humantix, etc.) to register. Please see their respective Privacy Policies on their website for more information. We do not share this information with outside parties except to the extent necessary to process your class registration for MCLE credit.

To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the correct use of information, we have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.
