
Renewing an LPS Conservatorship

Lanterman-Petris-Short Act (LPS) conservators may be appointed for “any person who is gravely disabled as a result of mental disorder or impairment by chronic alcoholism” when that person is unwilling or unable to accept treatment voluntarily. ([California Welfare & Institutions Code \(WIC\) §§5350, 5352](#) (http://leginfo.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=WIC§ionNum=5350) .) Because they restrict the conservatee’s civil rights, they are time-limited; they expire after one year unless the conservator successfully petitions for reappointment.

In Sacramento, LPS conservatorships are initiated by the Public Guardian (through the County Counsel). When possible, family members are appointed as Conservators of the Person, as they are better suited to ascertain the conservatee’s personal needs on a day-to-day basis.

The primary special power of an LPS conservator is the right to place the conservatee in a treatment facility. [WIC §5358\(a\)](#) (http://leginfo.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=WIC§ionNum=5358) . The order appointing the conservator may also restrict the conservatee’s right to a driver’s license, to enter into contracts, to vote, to refuse or consent to treatment related to the disability, to refuse or consent to treatment unrelated to the disability, and to possess firearms. [WIC §5357](#) (http://leginfo.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=WIC§ionNum=5357) . These restrictions must be listed specifically in the order to be effective.

Although the Public Guardian initially assists the family member in being appointed Conservator of the Person, the conservators must renew the appointment every year without the aid of the Public Guardian. Renewal requires obtaining and filing several doctors’ declarations as well as a *Petition for Reappointment* and other documents. This Guide contains forms and instructions to assist in the renewal.

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Obtain Doctors’ Declarations

A minimum of 45 days prior to the expiration date of the current conservatorship, send the doctors the declarations for execution. The forms needed for the declarations are:

2. Complete the Required Forms

You will also need copies of the current “Order Granting Petition to Appoint LPS Conservator” and “Letters of Conservatorship.” Attach these to the *Petition* as Exhibit A and Exhibit B.

At the end of this Guide are completed samples of these forms. You may download forms and customizable templates from the links listed above.

3. Make Copies, File Petition, Get Hearing Date, and Have Citation Issued

Make two copies of each:

- *Petition for Reappointment of LPS Conservator*
- *Declarations of doctors regarding conservatee*
- *Citation for Conservatorship* (GC-320)
- *Letters of Conservatorship* (GC-350)
- *(Proposed) Order Granting Petition to Reappoint LPS Conservator*

Leave the original copies unstapled, and staple each copy.

File the original and one copy of your documents at the Family Relations Courthouse, 3341 Power Inn Road, in Sacramento. There is no fee required. Also ask the clerk to endorse (stamp) the second copy for you. Keep that copy for later.

The clerk will assign a hearing date.

Ask the clerk to “issue” (file-stamp) the *Citation*. You will receive the original *Citation* back, now stamped.

4. Fill Out Notice of Hearing

Now that you have a hearing date, fill out the *Notice of Hearing*. You will be having it personally served on the

conservatee and served by mail on the relatives and others who must be notified.

In item 1, list the documents you filed in Step 3. Photocopy all of the endorsed (file-stamped) documents from Step 3 to serve along with the Notice of Hearing. Make sufficient copies to serve one set each on everyone who is entitled to notice.

Who is entitled to notice?

- The conservatee
- the conservatee's attorney (the Public Defender),
- if the conservatee lives in a facility, the professional person in charge of the facility
- the county behavioral health director
- the county officer providing conservatorship investigations
- the conservatee's spouse, if any
- relatives to the second degree (parents, grandparents, siblings, children, and grandchildren) and
- anyone else the court instructs you to serve.

Under [California Probate Code §1822](#)

(http://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PROB§ionNum=1822), the *Notice of Hearing* must be personally served on the conservatee and on the conservatee's attorney (the Public Defender) and mailed to the remaining parties, at least 15 days before the hearing date. You cannot do this yourself or ask anyone who gets notice to do it. It must be done by a non-party who is over 18.

5. Have Citation, Petition, and Notice of Hearing Personally Served on Conservatee

A *Citation* and a copy of the *Petition* must be served on the proposed conservatee by personal delivery (by a non-party who is over 18) at least 15 days before the hearing.

Fill out, but do not sign, (1) the *Certificate of Service* on the last page of the *Citation* and (2) the *Proof of Personal Service of Notice of Hearing—Guardianship or Conservatorship* (GC-020(P)). **Make a copy of the filled-out-but-unsigned *Certificate of Service* and *Proof of Personal Service* before proceeding.**

The server then personally delivers to the conservatee and the conservatee's attorney (the Public Defender) the issued *Citation*, a copy of the *Petition* and all other documents filed in Step 3, and the Notice of Hearing, along with copies of the unsigned *Certificate of Service* and *Proof of Personal Service* forms.

The server then signs the *Certificate of Service* on the last page of the original *Citation* and the *Proof of Personal Service of Notice of Hearing—Guardianship or Conservatorship* (GC-020(P)) and gives the signed documents back to you.

6. Have Notice of Hearing and Petition Served by Mail on Relatives

Fill out, but do not sign, the *Proof of Service by Mail* on page 2 of the *Notice of Hearing*. You must separately list all people to be served. If you do not have room, you can attach [Attachment to Notice of Hearing Proof of Service by Mail \(Probate—Decedents' Estates and Guardianships and Conservatorships](#) (<http://courts.ca.gov/documents/gc020ma.pdf>), GC-20(MA) to list the remainder.

Be sure to check Box 5, "I served with the *Notice of Hearing – Guardianship or Conservatorship* a copy of the petition or other document referred to in the notice." **Make a copy of the unsigned *Proof of Service by Mail* on page 2 of the *Notice of Hearing* before proceeding.**

The server then mails a copy of the *Notice of Hearing* to each person listed.

The server then signs the *Proof of Service by Mail* form on page 2 of the *Notice of Hearing* and gives you the signed copy.

7. File Original Proofs of Service and Lodge Proposed Order and Letters

Make two copies of each:

- *Citation for Conservatorship* (GC-320) (with original signature on proof of service)
- *Notice of Hearing – Guardianship or Conservatorship* (GC-020), with original signature on proof of service (GC-020(P))
- Doctors' declarations supporting the Petitioner
- Doctor's declaration on capacity to consent to medical treatment
- *Letters of Conservatorship* (GC-350)
- *(Proposed) Order Granting Petition to Reappoint LPS Conservator*

Leave the original set unstapled. Staple and two-hole punch the other copies for insertion into a folder.

File and lodge the original and one copy of:

- *Citation for Conservatorship* (GC-320) (with original signature on proof of service)
- *Notice of Hearing – Guardianship or Conservatorship* (GC-020) (with original signature on proof of service, GC-020(P))
- Doctors' declarations supporting the Petitioner
- Doctor's declaration on capacity to consent to medical treatment
- *Letters of Conservatorship* (GC-350)
- *(Proposed) Order Granting Petition to Reappoint LPS Conservator*

File and lodge these documents in the Probate Department at the Family Relations Courthouse, 3341 Power Inn Road, Sacramento CA, 95826.

Get the clerk to endorse (file-stamp) the second copy of the documents and keep that set in your own file.

8. Contact Public Defender to Confirm Conservatee Has Been Interviewed

Check with the Public Defender to make sure they have interviewed their client, the conservatee.

9. Probate Notes (also called Calendar Notes)

About ten to twelve calendar days prior to the hearing, “Probate Notes” are issued by the court. Since these are confidential, you must visit the courthouse to check them.

Probate Notes list any deficiencies that should be filled in or fixed prior to the hearing. For instance, if notice was mistakenly given by mail when it needed to be personally served, the Probate Notes will alert you so that you can re-serve in time. You must respond and clear Probate Notes in advance of the hearing. You should check back every couple of days to see if additional Probate Notes have been added.

10. Attend Hearing and Pick Up Endorsed Copy of Order

On the hearing date, attend the hearing. It is recommended to bring file-stamped copies of all paperwork to the hearing. If all goes well, the court will issue the *Order Granting Petition to Reappoint LPS Conservator*. Obtain an endorsed copy of this *Order* from the clerk or bailiff before you leave the courtroom.

11. Have Clerk Issue Letters

Once you have the endorsed copy of the court order, go over to the probate court clerks’ counter and have them issue the *Letters of Conservatorship*.

12. Have Order and Letters Served

Have the *Order* and *Letters of Conservatorship* served by mail on the same list of people as served in Step 6, plus the conservatee, using the same process as in Step 6.

2. A conservatorship of the person may be created for a person who is unable properly to provide for physical health, food, clothing, or shelter. A conservatorship of the property (estate) may be created for a person who is unable to resist fraud or undue influence, or who is substantially unable to manage his or her own financial resources. "Substantial inability" may not be proved solely by isolated incidents of negligence or improvidence.

3. At the hearing a conservator may be appointed for your person estate
The appointment may affect or transfer to the conservator your right to contract, to manage your property, to give informed consent for medical treatment, to fix your place of residence, and to marry.

4. You may be disqualified from voting if you are found to be incapable of communicating, with or without reasonable accommodations, a desire to participate in the voting process. You will not be disqualified from voting on the basis that you do, or would need to do, any of the following to complete an affidavit of voter registration:
a. Sign the affidavit of voter registration with a mark or a cross, pursuant to Section 2150(b) of the Elections Code;
b. Sign the affidavit of voter registration by means of a signature stamp pursuant to Section 354.5 of the Elections Code;
c. Complete the affidavit of voter registration with the assistance of another person pursuant to Section 2150(d) of the Elections Code; or
d. Complete the affidavit of voter registration with reasonable accommodations.
