
Understanding the Name Change Process in Sacramento

In Sacramento, to petition the court to change a name of an adult or to change the name of a minor; download the instructional packet, including forms, from the Sacramento Superior Courts website: [General Name Change Packet \(CV-142n\)](https://www.saccourt.ca.gov/civil/docs/cv-142n.pdf) (<https://www.saccourt.ca.gov/civil/docs/cv-142n.pdf>).

Common Questions

If you are restoring your name after dissolution of marriage, you can ask the family court to restore your former name.

If changing the name of a minor over the age of 12, it is recommended that the minor write a declaration agreeing to the name change.

If the other parent cannot be served because their location is unknown, the petitioning parent must submit a declaration detailing all attempts made to locate the other parent.

Once the name change is granted, in order to amend a California birth certificate, you will need to contact the [California Office of Vital Records](http://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CHSI/Pages/Vital-Records.aspx). (<http://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CHSI/Pages/Vital-Records.aspx>)

Giving a child a different name from the father's or otherwise changing the child's name does not affect the parent-child relationship or the legally recognized identity of the parents.

Now That You Have Changed Your Name, What Do You Do Next?

SOCIAL SECURITY

- To obtain a Social Security card in your new name, file an Application for a Social Security Card (Form SS-5). Form is available at www.ssa.gov, at your local Social Security office or by calling 1-800-772-1213. You will need to submit the form in person at your local office.
- In addition to the completed form you will need to provide a certified copy of your decree or court order and a photo ID.

DRIVER'S LICENSE

- Once you have your new social security card you can apply for a new driver's license. This must be done in person. You can find your local DMV office here: http://apps.dmv.ca.gov/fo/offices/toc_fo.htm
- You will need to complete Form DL-44. Check the box on the form for "Name Change." In addition to the completed form you will need to provide a certified copy of your decree or court order.

Once you have been issued your new Social Security card and new Driver's License you can tackle any other agencies or businesses that need your new name. The following is a list of common places you may need to contact.

PASSPORT

VOTER REGISTRATION

BIRTH CERTIFICATE

- An amendment can be attached to your birth certificate to reflect your new name. If you were born in CA, you will need a certified copy of your Decree Changing Name, and will need to submit it and an original Form VS-23 to the CA Office of Vital Records. You may obtain this form online at <https://www.cdph.ca.gov/CDPH%20Document%20Library/ControlledForms/VS23.pdf> If you were born in another state you will need to contact the appropriate agency in that state for their procedures.
