The site will ask you for state abbreviation and password. Enter your two-letter state abbreviation as indicated and your county of residence as the password in lower-case.

Download Digital Library app from the Apple App Store or Google Play.

Enter the library code **saclaw**. You will need your law library card number and your PIN associated with your library account
