HOMESTEAD DECLARATION

NEXT STEPS:

- 1. Person declaring the Homestead, sign the Homestead Declaration in front of a notary public.
- 2. Record the Homestead Declaration at the Recorder's Office in the county where the property is located. If you attached the property description (instead of typing it out), be sure to include the attachment when you record the Homestead Declaration.
- 3. Fees: There are two fees: a filing fee (currently \$20/first page plus \$3/additional page in Sacramento) and (as of Jan. 1, 2018) a \$75 Building Homes and Jobs Act fee. Current Sacramento fees are available at the Sacramento County Recorder's website at www.ccr.saccounty.net/Pages/Fees.aspx.

There are some exemptions from the \$75 fee. If you qualify, fill out the **Declaration of Exemption from Gov't Code 27388.1 Fee** box on page one of the declaration, or you will be charged. If not, leave it blank.
